Key words: 3-6 key words divided by commas (no point at the end)

JEL: 1-3 codes of JEL classification divided by commas – the codes can be found online at <http://www.aeaweb.org/econlit/jelCodes.php?view=jel> (e.g. L93, K41)

1 Introduction

Text of the paper should contain a minimum of 18,000 characters. Please use font Times New Roman, size 12, single spacing throughout the text. The text should be aligned to both margins (justified). Each paragraph should be indented from the left margin (1.25 cm).

For section titles, please use Times New Roman, size 14, bold. All sections should be numbered subsequently, starting with “1 Introduction”. Do not use subsections, unless really necessary. In that case use Times New Roman, size 12, bold, for subsection titles.

The introduction should state goals of the research and briefly present the methods which will be applied.

2 Title of section

Use footnotes for citations and references. The style to be used is as follows – SURNAME, F. (year): Title of the book or paper, page.² Full reference (including www link, if applicable) should be given at the end of the paper in the “References” section.³

Equations should be created in Microsoft Word, using italics. All equations should be numbered. Please leave a blank line before and after equation.

To better present results of the research, it is advisable to use tables and figures. All tables and figures should be references in text of the paper (figure 1). Titles of all tables and figures must be clear and concise (table 1). The content and message of all tables and figures
