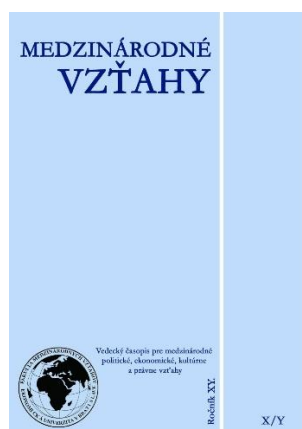

History of the castle

The location of Smolenice Castle is on the north side of the village. It was built at the beginning of the 20th century on the ruins of a medieval castle. The original castle was built in the 14th century. Individual owners enlarged it and adapted it to their needs and tastes. At the end of the 18th century, the castle fell into disrepair and burned down at the beginning of the 19th century.

The Smolenice Castle was started to be built at the beginning of the 20th century by Count Jozef Pálffy Sr. (1853 – 1920), the owner of the Smolenice and Dobrovodsk estates. The first works began in 1887 with the modification of the bastions and the construction of a chapel in the southern bastion. The bastions from the old castle remained, only they were extended and roofed. You can still see the old masonry and the newer superstructure on them. The entrance is secured by two gates, an old gate - wooden, ironed with copper sheet, and a new gate made of iron pipes, which is used during the day. At night, the entrance is closed by an old copper gate, which was made at the beginning of the 20th century, but was installed only in 1950. The gate is the only entrance to the castle.

The actual construction of the main castle building began in 1911. The massive main building consists of two wings: the left wing faces southeast from the tower, the right wing faces northeast. The entire building with the tower is made of reinforced concrete. According to the memories of older citizens from Smolenice, Portland cement was used for the first time in the construction of the castle. Count Pálffy had two plans drawn up for the construction of the castle, one in Vienna and the other in Budapest. He chose the one that most resembled the castle in Kreuzenstein near Vienna. This castle was owned by his mother Countess Wilczek.

The completed and modernized castle was handed over to the SNR of the Slovak Academy of Sciences on the day of its birth, June 26, 1953. Since then, the Smolenice Castle has become the centre of scientific workers of the Slovak Academy of Sciences. It is a suitable and representative place for scientific purposes, where meetings of foreign scientists with our leading teachers occur. It was necessary to secure and equip it with facilities that meet modern accommodation requirements. And so, at the beginning of 1955, the Slovak Academy of Sciences began the second stage of the construction of the castle. In particular, electrical installations, central heating, sewerage and water supply, hot water distribution, medical equipment of buildings, meeting network equipment were made. The second stage of the castle's construction ended in 1957.
